CLUB BY-LAWS OUTLINE

A Club may choose to elaborate on their Constitution, by writing By-Laws. By-Laws are a set of rules used to govern the Club's meetings. Club constitutions are not required to have By-Laws unless the constitution does not cover the subjects listed below. By-Laws ordinarily include the following:

- 1. Kinds of membership.
- 2. Detailed requirements for membership.
- 3. Method of admitting members.
- 4. Powers and duties of officers.
- 5. Powers and duties of committees.
- 6. Election of officers and committees, including the vote required for election.
- 7. Provisions for calling and conducting meetings.
- 8. Parliamentary authority.
- 9. Number constituting a quorum.
- 10. Vote required for important decisions.
- 11. Procedure for amending By-Laws.
