

Starfish Early Alert Allows Faculty to Communicate with Students

- Mandatory Progress Surveys for students in Athletics, DSPS, EOPS, ISSP, and those who are on academic probation (week 6 through the start of week 8)
- Optional Progress Survey for all students (week 3 through the start of week 5)
- Available any time in the semester for all general population students

Flags and Kudos

- Five Flags: Attendance Concern, Low Scores, Missing Assignments, Suggestion to Improve Performance, and In Danger of Failing
 - Use the first four to communicate with your students to help them get back on track.
 - The fifth flag, In Danger of Failing, goes to the student as well as to an academic counselor or special program advisor: the student will be contacted and asked to come in for academic planning.
 - Edit suggested language for the auto-generated email notification in order to give your students specific information about what they need change and to communicate in your own voice.
 - The In Danger of Failing Flag requires a specific comment from the instructor in order to make the meeting with the counselor or special program advisor more valuable.
- Four Kudos: Keep Up the Good Work, Outstanding Academic Performance, Outstanding Performance, and Showing Improvement
 - Raise kudos in order to recognize students when they are performing well in your classes.
 - Add an individual comment to the suggested language for the autogenerated email notification so that your recognition will be more meaningful.
- **Six Referrals:** Academic Counseling, Drop-In Tutoring, EOPS, Gateway Tutor Referral, Math Lab, and Writing Center
 - Direct your students to seek the help they need
 - Edit suggested language for the auto-generated email notification in order to personalize your referral
